- Show that we care about all students, address each student's needs, encourage individual talents, and respect the uniqueness of all students and their families.
- Provide parents opportunities to support their child's education by participating as follows: joining your child for lunch, chaperoning field trips, volunteering, serving on school and/or district committees, attending school events and meetings, and reviewing Title I plans and compacts.
